

# Condition and Purpose of *OTHER* Specialised Clean Questions (outside the BIG-5)

Client Context / Conditions	Facilitator Purpose	Specialised / Contextual / Conditional Clean Question
[X] is a plural or references a group or multiple events.	... the number of: X's, in group X or occurrences.	• <b>And how many [X] could there be?</b>
A symbol with human-like characteristics.	... the age of X. [used particularly with <i>Child Within</i> processes]	• <b>And how old could [X] be?</b>
A child-symbol.	... the clothes of a child-symbol (as a prelude to it having a body).	• <b>And what could [child-symbol] be wearing?</b>
A symbol [X] with an undesirable adjective [Y] (e.g. A bad boy).	... the attributes of X before the adjective Y was attached.	• <b>And what kind of [X] was that [X], before (it/he/she) was [Y]?</b>
A symbol is located at some distance from a Perceiver (or another symbol)	... the distance between.	• <b>And how far is [location]?</b>
Location of [X] unspecified in relation to a container (eg. a body)	... the location of X relative to the container.	• <b>And is [X] (on the) inside or outside?</b>
A symbol is moving, pointing, heading, facing somewhere.	... the direction of movement, pointing, heading, facing.	• <b>And in which direction is/does [movement/pointing/facing]?</b>
Perceiver [X] is perceiving (seeing, hearing, feeling, sensing, etc) [Y].	... the location of perceiver	• <b>And where is [X] [perceiving word] [Y] from?</b>
Names/attributes of [X] and [Y] are same/similar but they may be different.	... a comparison of qualities of X and Y.	• <b>And is [X] the same or different as/to [Y]?</b>
[X] and [Y] are separated in space or time.	... the nature of the space or event between X and Y.	• <b>And what's between [X] and [Y]?</b>
The client's logic presupposes [X] and [Y] relate/interact/influence each other.	... the nature of an interaction, influence or relationship, between X and Y.	• <b>And is there a relationship between [X] and [Y]?</b>
Nonverbals suggest a significant unspoken here-and-now response.	... their in-the-moment (or just happened) experience.	• <b>And what's happening now?</b> • <b>And what just happened?</b>
An event [X] has a long duration.	... what's follows the 'end' of the event.	• <b>And what happens after [X]?</b>
An agent [X] wants/needs to do an action [Y].	... whether X has the capability to do Y.	• <b>And can [X] [behaviour Y]?</b>
[X] and [Y] are choices/directions etc.	... the factors which influence the choice or decision.	• <b>And what determines whether [X] or [Y]?</b>
[X] is an unspecified experience of a perceiving symbol [Y].	... Y's evidence or criteria for X happening.	• <b>And how does [Y] know [X]?</b>
Part of the client's body is active while they are exploring experience [X].	... if the body part 'knows' anything about X.	• <b>And is there anything [nonverbal/body part] knows about [X]?</b>
Client looking at one or more drawings of their metaphor landscape.	... to select an aspect of their drawing that has significance for them.	• <b>And where are you drawn to?</b>
Client looks fixedly in a direction or repeatedly returns to look in a direction.	... whatever (internally or externally) is at the 'end' of the clients gaze.	• <b>And where are you going when you go there [line of sight]?</b>
